Assistance Available for Primary Producers Affected by Dry Seasonal Conditions

The Rural Financial Counselling Service Victoria North East (RFCS), delivered by AgBiz Assist, is available to support eligible farmers and agribusiness across North East Victoria who are experiencing financial pressure due to ongoing dry seasonal conditions. RFCS provides a free, confidential, and independent service designed to assist primary producers in understanding their financial position, exploring available support options, and planning for long-term sustainability. Our experienced Rural Financial Counsellors are available to guide clients through a range of assistance measures, including:

Farm Drought Support Grants Program | Rural Finance

A grant of up to \$5,000 (excluding GST) per eligible primary production business is available statewide, requiring a dollar for dollar matching co-contribution. The grant covers activities like constructing new or upgrading existing: Stock Containment Areas (SCA); reticulated water systems; irrigation system upgrades; grain and fodder storage; internal re-fencing to better match property layout; feed system upgrades; pasture/crop restoration; and water carting for livestock and essential business activities.

Previously paid invoices for drought infrastructure works completed from 30th Sept 2024 may be claimed without the need for quotes and pre-approval. http://www.ruralfinance.com.au/grants/

Agriculture Victoria | One-on-one farm advisory service

Farmers anywhere in Victoria can register now for a one-on-one farm advisory consultation, to take stock and discuss the best way forward for their business. The consultation includes a session of up to 3 hours (face to face on farm or online) and a follow-up call, to develop and implement a drought management action plan.

The session aims to identify key business and farm risks, stress and/or pressure points, conduct feed and/or water budgets etc, explore options and trigger points for the short, medium and long term, e.g. whether to de-stock or lease and provide referrals to other support services where relevant.

Farm Debt Mediation process | Victorian Small Business Commission Under this scheme it is compulsory for banks and other creditors to offer mediation to farmers before commencing debt recovery proceedings on farm mortgages.
