

# Maintaining profitable farming systems with retained stubble in the Riverine Plains

The project has established four focus farms with large, commercial scale trials to compare a range of stubble management options, with supporting small scale trials which focus on specific issues such as row spacing and cultivar selection, N timing and disease management.

# On-farm focus groups – retained stubble

The first series of paddock walks for the 2017 season will focus on crop establishment and vigour under the various stubble management options. We will also be discussing the cumulative yield results from previous seasons and check out how cold it actually got under the different stubble treatments.

Speakers will include Michael Straight (FAR Australia) and Cassandra Schefe (Riverine Plains Inc).
