

- Fungicide resistance in the eastern states: The current situation and what it means for crop management. *Dr Fran Lopez, Centre for Crop and Disease Management*
- Using NDVI to determine N rate: results from 2016 trials *Dr Cassandra Schefe, Riverine Plains Inc.*
- What have we learnt about fertiliser practice in the region over the last 5 years? Lee Menhenett, Incitec Pivot Fertilisers
