## **Location 1 – Chickpeas**

9:30 am: Meet at Wayne Spinks' chickpea paddock, 379 Goorambat-Chesney Rd, Goorambat.

## **Location 2 – Faba Beans**

10:45 - 11 am (approximately): Meet at Sinclair's sheds, 'Summerlea', 2604 Benalla-Yarrawonga Rd, Devenish.

***Growers interested in learning more about pulses, including lentils and chickpeas, are invited to join the Riverine Plains Inc Pulse Check discussion group paddock walk and discussion.***

The GRDC Southern Pulse Extension project is delivered by a consortium of organisations involved in the pulse industry across GRDC's Southern region.

Attendees do not need to have attended the previous meeting or have any prior knowledge in pulse production to attend.

The paddock walk will include visits to chickpea and faba bean crops near Goorambat and Devenish, Victoria. Discussions at each paddock will focus on crop establishment and early-season issues including;

- Response to sowing time, sowing rate and depth
- Plant density
- Early establishment pests and strategies
- Early crop disease identification and control strategies
- Early crop weed control strategies
- Update on market developments/opportunities for lentils, chickpeas and other pulses
