FRI 03 JUL Melbourne –Bucharest

Depart Melbourne 9-35pm

Arrives Bucharest 11-55am Sat 04 JUL

On arrival we will be met and transferred to our Hotel.

After a freshen up we enjoy a scenic afternoon tour of Bucharest, the capital and commercial Centre, this afternoon we visit the iconic landmark, the massive communist-era Parlementului government building, which has over 1100 rooms. We learn today the history of Romania during its Communist Rule under the control of Ceausescu and the 1989 bloody Romanian Revolution.

Tonight free to relax after our long flight.

SUN 05 JUL Bucharest B

After a leisurely morning we enjoy a city tour of Bucharest, known as the Paris of the East. We discover the old and the new of this dynamic and energetic city.

MON 6 JUL Bucharest- Barlad B

Today we depart by Coach to Barlad, a town of 25 thousand people, in Vaslui County, Romania. It lies on the banks of the Bârlad River, which waters the high plains of Moldavia.

Our drive today takes us through the Romanian countryside and into the Grain belt. On arrival we will meet Lawrence Richmond who works for NCH Capital who farm overs 1 million Acres with over 50 farms, Lawrence Manages 2 farms, one in Romania and one in the Ukraine.

TUE 7 JUL Barlad B D

Lawrence will join us today as we visit his grain cropping farm as well as tour the area, this part of Romania has recently transformed from small farms and commune farms to foreign investment into Agriculture. (Romania will be in the middle of Harvest.)

Dinner tonight at a local restaurant with Lawrence and local farmers.

WED 8 JUL Barlad- Chisinau B

This morning we continue by coach and travel to the Republic of Moldova, an Eastern European country and former Soviet republic with a population of 3.5 Million and only 20years of being a country, after crossing the border we visit the Village of Raciula, here we visit a local farm and enjoy a traditional lunch.. After lunch we travel to the Capital Chisinau, where we enjoy a tour with a local guide where we will see Soviet-style architecture, after our tour we enjoy wine tasting at Asconi Winery. Tonight free to enjoy.

THUR 9 JUL Chisinau-Odessa B

We continue our travel through the Republic of Moldova, with our first visit to a local Vineyard, at Chateau Purcari; here we look at the wine industry in Moldova, and in fact Moldova has the same amount of land under vineyards as Australia. After we cross the border into the Ukraine and make our way to Odessa, the famous Port City in southern Ukraine on the Black Sea. On arrival into Odessa we tour the port city of Odessa and its amazing streets and sights, we also visit the port area of Odessa and a crushing facility owned by Delta Wilmar and the port of Odessa that handles up to 1800 MT per day. Tonight Free.

FRI 10 JUL Odessa B

Today a full day tour, we travel by coach to a large wheat growing area near Kherson and look at wheat production and Harvesting. Evening return Odessa and time to enjoy dinner at one of the many restaurants. (Please note that those who wish can choose to have a free day exploring Odessa).

SAT 11 JUL Odessa B

Free day in Odessa, time to explore and enjoy the shopping and culture or enjoy the many beautiful beaches.

SUN 12 JUL Odessa-Kiev B

Today we travel by coach through the centre of the Ukraine enroute to the Ukrainian Capital Kiev, as we travel we will visit a local cropping farm in one of the highest productive areas of the Ukraine. Late afternoon arrive Kiev.

MON 13 JUL Kiev -Lviv B

Our first visit today is to the Ministry of Agriculture for a discussion on Agriculture and Trade, we then enjoy a city highlights tour of the capital. We then take the afternoon train to Lviv. The 5 hour train trip arrives at 7-30pm, on arrival we are transferred to our hotel.

TUE 14 JUL Kiev- Lviv B

Lviv a city in the western Ukraine, around 70klm from the Polish border, it traces its heritage through Polish and Austro-Hungarian which is evident in its architecture and is a city that blends central and eastern European styles. Lviv is the 7th largest city in the Ukraine and is well known for its liveliness and Jazz music. Todays full day tour of the area looking at local agriculture, we visit a local farm growing 1800 hectares of grain and about to be harvested, we also meet with local farmers for a brief discussion.

WED 15 JUL Lviv-Krakow E

Our morning Train to Krakow departs at 7-55am and arrives into Krakow, Poland at 1-50pm. On arrival we meet our local guide and are transferred to our hotel. This afternoon we enjoy a walking city tour, then for those inclined enjoy dinner at a local brew house. End of Tour.

THUR 16 JUL Krakow B

Our tour today features a visit to the famous Salt Mines of Krakow, we then visit a local chemical and fertilizer distributer.

In the afternoon we look at agriculture in the surrounding area, as Poland has always been known as the breadbasket of Europe.

Tonight free to enjoy the many restaurants and bars that Krakow has to offer.

FRI 17 JUL Krakow B

Morning excursion by coach to Auschwitz, the former concentration camp of Nazi Germany before returning to Krakow and enjoying a free afternoon for some last minute shopping.

Tonight optional I dinner at a local traditional Jewish restaurant in the famous Jewish sector.

SAT 18 JUL Krakow-Prague B

Our day begins with a beautiful 6 hour train trip to Prague ,the capital of the Czech Republic on arrival we make our way to the hotel.

SUN 19 JUL Prague B

This morning enjoy a walking tour of Prague. Afternoon free to explore this beautiful city.
